****This serves as an addendum to the General Order to Establish Local Rules and Protocol For Reopening Jefferson District Court, Effective June 15, 2020.***

As the Reopening order indicates, “Juvenile court proceedings will be conducted remotely pursuant to Supreme Court Order 2020-39, unless the Judge determines and provides notice that a hearing or matter will be heard in person.”

Court is being held via Zoom or telephone only.

All parties, witnesses, and attorneys will receive the Zoom/telephonic appearance information through court notice.

If you do not receive notice from the Court, and want to appear remotely on a juvenile matter, please email: jeffersonjuvenile@kycourts.net.

*If you cannot afford an attorney, the Court will appoint one for you at the Arraignment.

- Beginning 6/15/20, Jefferson District Juvenile Court will resume hearing non-detained juvenile petitions remotely Monday through Friday beginning at 8:30 a.m.
- Motions for in-person hearings or trial must be made at least ten (10) days prior to scheduled hearing or trial date and emailed to both the presiding Judge and opposing counsel.
- All hearings will be scheduled at a time designated by the Court. Hearings not heard due to court closure will be rescheduled chronologically by the Court.
- All juvenile dockets shall be recorded in the JAVS and/or Zoom platform for the official court record of proceedings.
