**ORDER REGARDING EARLY DISMISSAL OF
COURTS FOR WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 11, 2021**

In order for the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office to attend and appropriately staff the funeral ceremony for Deputy Brandon Shirley, the Jefferson County Courts will be dismissed early on Wednesday August 11th 2021. Jefferson District, Family and Circuit Courts will finish most regular business by 10:00 am.

Jefferson District Court will hold the regular arraignment docket beginning at 8:30 am until it is concluded. Cases with a 10- or 20-day deadline pursuant to RCr 3.10 will be rolled until the next day as the Court hereby finds extraordinary circumstances exist that necessitate the suspension of the rule. Jefferson Circuit and Family Courts may conduct regular business and hear arraignments and bench warrants until 10:00 am on August 11th.


As necessary, any court may continue to hold a previously scheduled civil docket that can be conducted completely remotely with the courtroom door locked. Additionally, any jury trial in-process on August 11th may continue.
